5 DAYS 4 NIGHTS BHUTAN TOUR

DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR - KATHMANDU - PARO - THIMPHU (D)

The flight to Paro on a clear day is one of the most spectacular – you can view Mt Everest, Kanchenjunga, Makalu and other peaks in Bhutan. Arrival at Paro Airport. Meet & greet and proceed to check into the hotel. Afternoon, proceed to visit **National Memorial Chorten**: a monument for world peace and prosperity. Later visit **Trashichhoedzong** This impressive fortress/monastery houses Secretariat building, the King and various government offices. Drive to **Buddha Point (Kuensel Phodrang)**. You can pay your obeisance and offer prayers to the Buddha, the largest statue in the country. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 2 THIMPHU (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, proceed sightseeing visit **National Library**, which holds a vast collection of ancient Buddhist texts and manuscripts. Also visit nearby **Institute for Zorig Chusum**: Commonly known as Arts & Crafts School or Painting School. Textile Museum: With the opening of Textile Museum, Bhutanese textile have reached new heights as one of the most visible distinct art form. In the afternoon in Thimphu visit **Changangkha Lhakhang**: It is a fortress like temple and monastic school perched on a ridge above Thimphu, south of Motithang. Takin Sanctuary: The Takin is the national animal of Bhutan. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 3 THIMPHU - PARO (B/LD)

Breakfast at Hotel, proceed to Paro: en route visit **Simtokha Dzong**. Upon arrival in Paro, check in at the Hotel. Afternoon in Paro visit Ta Dzong: a watchtower, built to defend Rinpung Dzong during inter-valley wars of the 17th century, **Ta Dzong** was inaugurated as Bhutan's National Museum, walk down a hillside trail to visit **Rinpung Dzong**, which has a long and fascinating history. Built in 1646 by Shabdrung Ngawang Namgyal, the first spiritual and temporal ruler of Bhutan, the Dzong houses the monastic body of Paro, the office of the Dzongda (district administrative head) and Thrimpon (judge) of Paro district. The approach to the Dzong is through a traditional covered bridge called Nemi Zam. Overnight at hotel

DAY 4 PARO (B/L/D)

Breakfast at Hotel, proceed Morning excursion to **Taktshang Lhakhang** (approx. 5 hrs. walking excursion): 'Tiger's Nest'. This site has been recognized as a most sacred place and visited by Shabdrung Ngawang Namgyal. On the drive towards Paro town en route visiting **Kichu Lhakang**, one of the oldest monasteries of the Kingdom reflecting introduction of Buddhism in Bhutan. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 5 DEPART PARO - KATHMANDU - KUALA LUMPUR (B)

Breakfast at hotel, Transfer to airport for onward destination.

- Visa Info :
Tourism Council of Bhutan issues visa clearance letter closer to travelling date (1 week before arrival) which Magadh Travels & Tours, will email you directly. Travelers are required to produce aforesaid visa clearance copy at the time of check-in for Druk Air flight while those entering Bhutan by surface via Phuntsholing or Samdrup Jonkhar, they are required to produce this Visa Clearance letter at the Immigration counter. Actual visa is stamped on passport on arrival in Bhutan.
 - **Guests are required to have multiple entry visa for India if they are travelling to Bhutan from India and again re-entering into India from Bhutan. Please also check if your Indian visa has '2 months re-entry restriction'. If restriction has been stamped in your Indian visa, you have to get it endorsed by Indian embassy in Thimphu also but you need to be in Thimphu on working days, Mon – Fri during office time excluding Govt holidays, to allow you to re-enter India. You will be asked to provide the proof of your travel to Bhutan (Druk air booking etc).
